

1 HOLLOWAY: Karen, we have a question for you if you  
2 would come on up? Would you please refrain from clapping and noise because  
3 we need to get on, we need to just get the testimony and that's what we are  
4 really here for, so that...we'd appreciate it, it doesn't help us at all. So, Rick?

5 BARKER: Yes, Richard?

6 SHEEHAN: Karen, thank you. I don't have a copy of the actual  
7 survey in front of me. I do have your notes that you just got through speaking  
8 about. You said that there's this threat for people who wanted to move if the  
9 towers were built. Have you got any statistics?

10 BARKER: Not necessarily move, but enroll their children some  
11 where else and there's a real distinction there.

12 SHEEHAN: Okay. Are there any statistics or surveys that show  
13 people that in fact have moved or will be moving shortly as a result of these  
14 towers, even the ones in place?

15 BARKER: No. I think that would be a very good one to do. We  
16 may very well want to do a follow-up to that. Thanks for that suggestion.

17 SHEEHAN: Okay.

18 HOLLOWAY: For those of you who are standing there's probably,  
19 there are some empty seats throughout here if you'd like to sit.

20 BOLTON: My name is Roberta Bolton and I have resided at  
21 1713 Utah Street in Jefferson County for the last 12 and 1/2 years.

22 HOLLOWAY: Okay, now where? Oh, you're clear down here.  
23 Okay. B-O-L-T-O-N?

1 BOLTON: Yes. B-O-L-T-O-N. and I wasn't here for the  
2 swearing in.

3 HOLLOWAY: So do you need to be sworn in?

4 BOLTON: If I wasn't.

5 HOLLOWAY: Uh huh.

6 CLERK: Do you solemnly swear the testimony you are about  
7 to give is the truth, the whole truth and nothing but the truth so help you God?

8 BOLTON: I do. I am the mother of two young children and an  
9 active volunteer in my community, my children's schools and my church all of  
10 which lie within a five-mile radius of the proposed tower. As president of Shelton  
11 Elementary's P.T.A., an elementary school which lies directly below the  
12 proposed tower, I am here tonight to express my concerns with the danger  
13 involved with placing this tower so close to our children. I would like to read to  
14 you an excerpt I found at the Jefferson County internet site. The goals of the  
15 Jefferson County Board of Commissioners are to preserve this quality of life, not  
16 only for those of us who are here now but for the enjoyment of future  
17 generations by responsible planning and safeguarding the rights of property  
18 owners making it a safe place to live, work and raise our families. As a citizen of  
19 Jefferson County I ask that you look carefully tonight at who we are, not paid  
20 professionals with financial stake in this project but as citizens, residents, moms  
21 and dads. We come to you tonight leaving our hectic schedules of kids and  
22 families to ask you to carefully consider the impact that more radiation more  
23 interference and this immense structure will have on our community. And what

1 effect will this have on our schools computers sound equipment, and  
2 communications at Shelton? We don't know conclusively the health effects of  
3 this additional radiation. However, there are studies being done worldwide that  
4 suggest that our legal limits are far too high. Until we have more research that is  
5 done not in the interest of the broadcasters but in the interest of the health and  
6 safety of the citizens we ask you to not let our children and our families be  
7 unwilling subjects in this potentially tragic experiment. Please oppose the  
8 construction of the Lake Cedar's Group super tower. There are far too many  
9 unknown risks to the students and citizens of Jefferson County. Thank you.

10 HOLLOWAY: Now are we going to go by this list?

11 CARNEY: Yes. We are now in order. Dr. Henry Lai. I  
12 would like to do an introduction of him right now. It is my pleasure tonight to  
13 introduce to you a scientist who has traveled from the University of Washington  
14 in Seattle to testify without charge to us who has become quite renowned for his  
15 research on the biological effects of electromagnetic radiation. In fact he was  
16 interviewed by 20/20 extensively yesterday. Dr. Henry Lai is in the Department  
17 of Bio-engineering. He has over 60 published papers. You'll see his biography  
18 in there, the list goes on and on. He is on the Board of Directors of the Bio-  
19 electromagnetic Society. He has done research for the office of Naval Research  
20 on the neural-physiological and behavioral effects of microwave exposure, which  
21 is a form of electromagnetic radiation. He has done research for the National  
22 institute of Health, Environmental Health Science on DNA damage from  
23 electromagnetic radiation, neural effects and the effects on the brain physiology
