

1 Jefferson County Commissioners should be expected to worry over such  
2 matters as the signal to Boulder, the most accessible and read cheapest  
3 broadcast location. The quality of the signal or the alleged lack thereof are  
4 indeed whether there is any HDTV broadcasting at all. These are Lake Cedar's  
5 problems and solving them is not included in the job description for our  
6 Commissioners. Their responsibility is to represent the citizens who elected  
7 them. In this case the health, welfare and property rights of thousands of these  
8 citizens must be considered. By their decision in this case the Commissioner's  
9 will demonstrate conclusively where their priorities and loyalties are. For the  
10 sake of all concerned we hope that those reside with their constituents. That's  
11 all I have to say.

12 SHEEHAN: Okay. Thank you Eugenie. Okay I misspoke with  
13 Carol Bryson. I guess she said originally she said she did not want to testify.  
14 Alfred Cooper? Alfred Cooper?

15 LAWRENCE: He's waving.

16 SHEEHAN: Is he waving? Where is he? Okay and then Cynthia  
17 Hildebrand and then Richard Over. Mark Hesse listed next. Mr. Cooper, please  
18 state your name, your last name. Spell your last name and provide your  
19 address for the record please?

20 COOPER: My name is Alfred Cooper, Jr. C-O-O-P-E-R. I live  
21 at 21888 Crestmore Drive. Are you ready?

22 SHEEHAN: Yes sir.

1 COOPER: I am too. At the so called BAMBI Planning Meeting  
2 there was one of your planners that asked if we worried about BAMBI's. Yes we  
3 value all living things. But we value the lives of ourselves, our children and our  
4 grandchildren. At that time I suggested by the Director two things, one to keep  
5 the towers away from people and to prepare and backup and do a moratorium. I  
6 got some looks like I thought I'd just gotten out of some mental facility. I find in  
7 doing some studies in New York State of the Hudson Bay project. At the time I  
8 was built, it was built excuse me, about 15, 20 years ago it was the largest  
9 hydroelectric project ever attempted in the world. One of the doctors, a Doctor  
10 Robert Obecker who has done a lot of work in electromagnetic radiation got a  
11 judge's decree for a five year moratorium and I can see...I can't see why you all  
12 can not go on a moratorium if it gets that far for this specific project. There is  
13 nothing besides lives. There's some questions that I have run into. I don't  
14 understand why Pensacola Florida has their own public utility which I...it's  
15 written must be allowed without a public hearing or a congressional mandate  
16 known as NCRP. They did this on their project and it was based on a  
17 congressional report number 86. There was also other electronic firms and  
18 divisions that had instituted their own standards to protect their employees,  
19 Hughes Aircraft, Lockheed Corporation, John Hopkins University, the Applied  
20 Physics Lab, it's similar to Kirkland Airforce Base's standards which are quite  
21 stringent. Puerto Rico has adopted their own, the whole state, the IRPA  
22 recommendations. Portland Oregon Zoning Department publishes a  
23 recommended radio frequency regulations.

1 SHEEHAN: Please wrap up Mr. Cooper.

2 COOPER: Yes. I think what needs to be really said here is we  
3 need to bring a sense of humanistic values back to the table. And to remember  
4 that erring on the side of caution has never proven an ill advised course of  
5 action and is certainly a more intelligent approach then the reckless abandon  
6 with which we have thus far embraced. Thank you very much.

7 SHEEHAN: Thank you. Cynthia Hildebrand? Cynthia? Not  
8 here? Richard Over?

9 OVER: Here.

10 SHEEHAN: And Mark Hesse?

11 OVER: My name is Richard C. middle initial Over, O-V-E-R.  
12 I purchased my property in 1953 from William Weller the developer of the  
13 Panorama Estates. That goes back a long ways and my wife and I consider  
14 ourselves the pioneers in that area. We purchased the property.

15 SHEEHAN: Could you state that property's address please, sir?

16 OVER: Pardon me sir?

17 SHEEHAN: State the address please. What is your address?

18 OVER: The address 21667 Mountsfield Drive.

19 SHEEHAN: Golden?

20 OVER: Golden, Colorado, 80401. I am in direct line of sight  
21 from all of the towers and since 1953 when there were only two towers up there.  
22 I've watched the development and in 1970 I established, I was a audiovisual  
23 technician teaching at Denver Community College. I established a small
