

1 welfare of the citizens you represent by rejecting the proposal for this new tower
2 on Lookout Mountain. Thank you for your time.

3 SHEEHAN: Okay. Questions? No. Okay, thank you sir. Okay
4 you said we have another homeowners association?

5 WOOD: Yes. I had received a request from Tripp Ranch
6 HOA with a designating Roger Mattson as their spokesman with two signatures.

7 SHEEHAN: Okay, Tripp Ranch. Have you had a chance to
8 swear in? Has Tripp Ranch sworn in? Okay.

9 UNKNOWN: Yes, we have. We have been sworn in and the
10 proper authority indicates that we have two speakers for the association.

11 SHEEHAN: Okay, but you still have ten minutes though.

12 UNKNOWN: We will likely use it.

13 SHEEHAN: Very good. Please state your name, your last name,
14 spell your last name and provide your address for the record please and your
15 homeowners association.

16 CUCHIARA: Thank you, my name is Charles Cuchiara. C-u-c-h-i-
17 a-r-a. I reside at 479 Crawford Street, Golden, Colorado which is in Tripp Ranch
18 and we are here on behalf of the Tripp Ranch Homeowners Association. My
19 previous address was 149 Kimble which is in Heritage Dells so I lived under the
20 towers for 23 years and I think I have some long term perspective on the towers.
21 Until now no one ever even suggested these towers could have harmful effects
22 on our health. Tripp Ranch is a subdivision that consists of 38 homes which
23 slides immediately north and west of Shelton Elementary. Their special concern

1 is for Shelton Elementary and the kids who attend that school given the
2 proximity of the towers to that grade school. Now I have a couple of thoughts to
3 share with you and then I'm going to turn over the remainder of my time to
4 Roger Mattson who has scientific knowledge in this area and can better speak to
5 the health effects. A third of our association, that's 38 homeowners
6 unanimously oppose the rezoning application before you today. I'm sure you've
7 heard much about the health effects and you will certainly hear more. The fact
8 of the matter is that you cannot and should not risk the health and well being of
9 citizens and children who live near this tower just to put a few more dollars into
10 the pockets of Channels 4, 7 and 9. As elected Commissioners you represent
11 the people of Jefferson County and in this instance those people who will be the
12 most adversely affected are those nearest the tower. The interests of your
13 constituent voters must take precedent over the special big money commercial
14 interests who propose the tower application. There are alternative sites
15 available. I'm particularly impressed by the Squaw Mountain presentation and
16 we respectfully request that you deny their rezoning application. We are
17 watching how you vote on this issue. If you neglect the interests of the citizens
18 you represent in favor of the commercial special interests of Lake Cedar Group,
19 then there is one thing that is for certain and that is that the citizens of Jefferson
20 County that live close to these towers will work to beat any candidate for
21 reelection who does not protect the interests of our families, their health and our
22 property values. Thank you and I'll now give the rest of my time to Mr. Mattson.
