

1 SCHLOSSBERG: Hi. I'm Shelly. Can everyone hear me? Is that on?
2 Can you hear me now?

3 HOLLOWAY: There you go.

4 SCHLOSSBERG: I'm Shelly Schlossberg-Doctor. I live at 22046
5 Panorama Drive. I'd like to keep this very brief and just reiterate that I agree with
6 CARE's position as well as the other people who have spoken so eloquently this
7 evening opposing this rezoning and I'd like to simply add to that that my husband
8 and I moved here two years ago from the east coast with a very specific intention
9 of living in an environment that focused on quality of life. And we chose
10 Jefferson County because we were aware of the vast wide open space that was
11 dedicated and the belief system that's been evident in our body of government as
12 well as with the citizens. And with that as evidence of previous experience I
13 would like to simply say that I have great faith in you as our Commissioners to
14 continue to do what is right for our community and I believe that you will thus vote
15 against this tower. Thank you very much.

16 HOLLOWAY: Thank you. Donald Patton? Oh, you do. Oh, I'm
17 sorry.

18 PATTON: Commissioners, the name is Don Patton. I live at 3
19 Charros Drive in Golden Colorado. I spent 23 years with the United States
20 Environmental Protection Agency both in DC and also out here in Lakewood with
21 the National Enforcement Investigation Center in the regional office down town. I
22 really don't have anything to add but to say that from a professional point of view

1 and from a personal point of view I want to support the people who have testified
2 in opposition to the tower. Thank you.

3 HOLLOWAY: Thank you. Brad Ross-Shannon? Is it Brad
4 Ross-Shannon?

5 ROSS-SHANNON: Yes. That's correct.

6 HOLLOWAY: Okay.

7 ROSS-SHANNON: My name's Brad Ross-Shannon. I live at
8 21890 Cabrini Boulevard. My wife Tracy and I live in Block 3 of the cancer
9 cluster. We've lived next door to what was one of the cancer victims. You
10 can see the towers from our homes. I don't have really much of anything to
11 add.

12 LAWRENCE: Move the microphone up a bit, Brad, please.

13 ROSS-SHANNON: The only thing that I would ask you, you've heard a lot
14 of very technical testimony, very compelling testimony. But I would ask that you
15 use your common sense. And I would ask that you ask yourselves what makes
16 sense for Jefferson County? What makes sense for the citizens of Lookout
17 Mountain and for the citizens and the residents that have been before you? The
18 quality of our lives are in your hands and our elected officials and I would ask that
19 you consider that when you are making your decision. Thank you.

20 HOLLOWAY: Thank you. Okay. Penne Goplerud?

21 GOPLERUD: Goplerud.

22 HOLLOWAY: Yep. That's it. That's you.
