

1 look at a video clip from the TV show, Extra, which Julia, and by chance I
2 appeared on. It was by chance that I appeared, not Julia. I happened to
3 be...they wanted her, they got me by chance. I happened to be visiting Julia
4 because she was recovering from a very serious medical problem and Extra
5 contacted her and was asked her if she was willing to be on the show. And
6 despite her recovery and the fact that she was not making any public
7 appearances at the time, this April, because of her deep concern about this issue
8 she was on the show. And as you will see on the show she expresses her
9 dismay that anyone would even consider erecting this tower if there are any
10 health risks. She says, (I can imitate her a little bit), "one does not experiment
11 with human beings". She is baffled that the tower's simply not put on an
12 alternate site up and away from children, schools, families and businesses. In a
13 recent phone call with her I told her I'd be speaking to all of you and she said,
14 "may your Commissioners have the wisdom and courage to say no to this tower".
15 I just want to close by saying I agree with all the testimony against the tower and
16 I ask you please to protect us from being subjects in a DTV radiation experiment.
17 Help us Commissioners. You are our only hope. Thank you.

18 HOLLOWAY: Gary Redish?

19 REDISH: My name is Gary Redish and I office at 534
20 Commons Drive in Golden. I am the executive pastor at Lookout Mountain
21 Community Church which is one of the larger churches in the area. We are
22 currently experiencing interference from the towers in our sound system now.
23 We are building about a four to five billion dollar building in Genesee Park,

1 Business Park and we were told the only way that we could avoid having any
2 kind of interference was to wrap the building in construction with copper wire
3 mesh. I'm concerned about that. I'm concerned about health problems. I'm
4 concerned about people in our congregation that are talking of selling their
5 homes and moving. And I just wanted to express my concern for that tonight.
6 Thank you.

7 HOLLOWAY: Thank you. And Brad Ross Shannon, we already got.
8 Okay. We are at the end of our list. Is there anyone that wishes to testify that
9 was not on this list? Oh, Margot? How come...you were on this list, how come I
10 passed you up? I'm sorry.

11 ZELLAN: Thank you. My name is Margot Zellan and I live on
12 Lookout Mountain. I'm here to testify tonight in two capacities. First as
13 chairperson of Plan Jeffco and second as a 28 year resident of Lookout
14 Mountain. For the record, Plan Jeffco launched the County's award winning
15 Open Space Program in 1972. And it's continued to be the citizen watch dog
16 group for the protection of the County's visual resources. Plan Jeffco reflects the
17 views of tens of thousands of County voters who overwhelmingly voted to
18 preserve our scenic vistas in 1972 and of the 71% of voters who supported the
19 1998 SOS bond issue. At the ballot box and in public opinion surveys, Jeffco
20 citizens consistently tell us that they want the unique land forms which define the
21 character of our County to be preserved. The mountain backdrop is without
22 doubt the area which defines our community. It is truly unique. You as County
23 Commissioners and every county commissioner in the 28 years that I have lived
