2 you.

3 SHEEHAN: Marston Shelton? Please, Marston Shelton and then
4 I think another Shelton there is it Har or?

5 UNKNOWN: It's Hal and he's not here.

6 SHEEHAN: He's not here? Okay.

7 SHELTON: My name is Marston Shelton, S-H-E-L-T-O-N. I live
8 in the Stonebridge Development in Golden at 19054 Eagle Ridge Drive, 80401.
9 This address gives my family the dubious distinction of living in one of the
10 closest houses to the existing towers that is within the city limits of Golden. If
11 the super tower is built in it's proposed new location it will be about one
12 kilometer from my front door and I would like to specify that that's full view of the
13 entire height of both towers. But the questionable owner of closest residents
14 within the city limits I believe goes to the house my parents live in at 850 Shelton
15 Road. Hal and Mary Shelton, my parents bought their home in 1953, 50 years
16 ago. Television broadcasting was just beginning. Had they thought to inquire
17 my parents would have been relieved to find that none of the land surrounding
18 their home was zoned for broadcast tower construction. It still is not. They had
19 no idea that when they moved here that one of the largest residentially located
20 antenna farms in the world would be constructed literally in their back yard. Hal
21 and Mary came to this hearing last Tuesday to register their opposition to this
22 rezoning. Due to their advanced age and failing health they were not able to
23 attend again today but they asked me to say a few words on their behalf. My

1 parents have had a life long interest in Jefferson County, it's schools and it's
2 children. My father served on the R-1 School Board for 11 years and was
3 president of the board for many of those years . During his tenure six bond
4 issues and about 35 schools were built in our county. My mother was recently
5 honored for her 50 years of service to the Golden Chapter of the League of
6 Women Voters. They were both thrilled and deeply touched when Jefferson
7 County choose them to name a new Golden School after. The Hal and Mary
8 Shelton Elementary School was dedicated in August of 1994. It is that school
9 that bears their names that concerns them most. Shelton Elementary is one of
10 five public schools in the immediate area surrounding the towers. It is in fact the
11 closest school to the towers. If as we fear there is a link between proximity to
12 the towers and dramatically increased health risks especially in children then
13 Shelton Elementary School honoring Hal and Mary will forever bear the
14 distinction of being one of the most environmentally dangerous schools in
15 Colorado for our children to attend. My parents do not care to have that as their
16 legacy. For my part despite the towers I chose to buy a house here in the area
17 where I grew up because it is quite simply the most beautiful place I know to
18 raise a family. I have very fond memories of roaming the foothills around
19 Golden with childhood friends and attending school in a place that even today
20 retains it's small town charm. Now our son Nicholas can't wait to begin
21 kindergarten this fall at Shelton Elementary School. Please do not force us to
22 move from our home. Don't make this super tower fiasco your legacy as County

1 Commissioners. Vote no on this and any tower rezoning issue that directly
2 affects the safety of our schools and residential areas. Thank you.

3 SHEEHAN: Thank you, Marston. Okay. So I understand that Hal
4 is not here then. Dave Sauer? S-A-U-E-R and Steve Close and then Margot
5 Zallen.

6 SAUER: Dave Sauer, S-A-U-E-R of 550 Columbine Avenue,
7 Lookout Mountain. I've been hearing debate about how much more less
8 radiation and interference this tower will produce. The way it is right now I
9 already experience interference across my garage door opener. My dog's got
10 two tumors that were removed cancerous and now one more. With all that in
11 today's conditions what can they expect if the new tower's built? The only
12 conclusion I come up with is that somebody in a fancy suit is going to get more
13 money in their pocket. We get more radiation, another tower. All that for a
14 better picture, better TV. We encourage our kids to go out and play in the
15 woods and things like that rather than watch TV. I turn off the TV if I don't like
16 what's on or I can't get reception but I can't turn off the radiation these towers
17 put out. For the sake of our community's health please don't approve this tower.
18 Thank you.
