4 from our in-laws which is the whole reason why we moved into Stonebridge. So
5 I guess that may not have been completely clear but the bottom line is I think we
6 will seriously have to consider moving out of Golden to the extent that these
7 towers go up. That's all I have tonight and I will spare you the rest of the
8 speech.

9 SHEEHAN: Thank you Theresa. Warren Kennison Jr? No
10 Warren? Shane Henry? Shane Henry? Okay. Brian Smith and then
11 Raweewan Hoontrakoon?

12 SMITH: My name is Brian Smith. I live at 21740 Cabrini
13 Boulevard. And in Golden 80401 and I've lived there since 1987 and we've
14 dealt with the towers for a long time and I've been to a lot of these hearings, not
15 quite as many as you but a lot and I agree with a lot of opposition that has been
16 presented here. We too had a dog that acquired lymphoma at a fairly early age.
17 We have recently remodeled our house and spent about \$8,000 trying to
18 mitigate the effects of the radio frequency and that was through shielding. We
19 put in some aluminum insulation. Basically it's a light gauge insulation and I
20 covered the windows with a sheeting material as well as we put in stucco over
21 the parts of the house that we remodeled to try and mitigate as well and I just
22 oppose the tower. I think it's a good opportunity to relocate the tower to another
23 location. I think there are alternatives and that's all I have to say.
