

1 SHEEHAN: Penny this person seems to have the same address  
2 as you Murray Wynes. Okay...Alright.

3 WYNES: And that's because we're married.

4 SHEEHAN: Okay very good.

5 WYNES: So my name is Murry Wynes. I live at 99 Dekker  
6 Drive on Lookout Mountain.

7 LAWRENCE: Spelling?

8 SHEEHAN: Spell your name.

9 WYNES: Excuse me, W-Y-N-E-S and what my wife did not  
10 mention was that our home is at 7,500 feet and in direct line of site of the  
11 towers. We are located southwest of the towers to give you an orientation. We  
12 are in block group three in the CSU study which I'm sure you have all read. I  
13 have a PHD in immunology from CU and have recently become aware of the  
14 literature regarding RF radiation in general in the Lookout Mountain area  
15 specifically. I ask that you consider the health risk very carefully before making  
16 a decision. The credible testimony from both Dr.'s Kelley and Frankel which I  
17 completely concur with was done voluntarily and without financial compensation.  
18 There is no way they would put themselves or their highly respected reputations  
19 on the line unless there was a valid concern. I do not understand how when  
20 there are all these reports coming to light and more research ongoing you can  
21 even consider allowing a new tower into the Lookout Mountain neighborhood.  
22 Lake Cedar Group has already said the radiation to the south where many  
23 people live would increase. And I find it hard to believe that if they're going to be

1 increasing power how the radiation will not be increased in other areas also.  
2 Remember that the towers are at the same elevations as our heads for the  
3 people who live on Lookout Mountain. Now having spent 6 years in the army I  
4 clearly understand the concept of sacrificing lives of a few for the greater good  
5 of the majority. However we should only be sacrificing lives in order to protect  
6 things like freedom and liberty and life itself, not so that we can have television  
7 transmitters in a residentially zoned neighborhood. When Thomas Jefferson  
8 spoke of inalienable rights he was speaking of life, and liberty and the pursuit of  
9 happiness, not a luxury like television. If you allow the super tower into the  
10 residential neighborhood you will be potentially denying the citizens the  
11 inalienable right of life and denying our right to pursue happiness. As a citizen  
12 we have a reasonable expectation that government will be mindful of our safety  
13 and happiness. People do not die without television but people do die from  
14 cancer. And a final thought or question, no need for an answer. If a few years  
15 from now the data shows without a doubt that RF causes cancer and the record  
16 shows that Jefferson County knew of the potential risk to let the super tower go  
17 up anyway is Jefferson County responsible? Can they be held liable? Thank  
18 you.
